Dear Parents and/or Guardians:

As we get closer to the May 2019 AP exam testing dates, here is some important information of which you should be aware.

- 1) **The cost per AP exam is \$94.00.** The guidance office will begin collecting exam monies in the beginning of February, and will inform students of the timeline as we get closer. Please note that students who receive free or reduced lunch are eligible for a reduced price per exam. Please contact your child's guidance counselor for further information on this.
- 2) **Test dates are as follows, testing locations to be announced at a later date:**

- 3) **Students who are classified, declassified, or 504 recipients** may be eligible to use their testing accommodations on the May 2019 AP exams, **only if** they have applied for these accommodations through the Collegeboard (the overseeing testing agency of AP exams), and if the Collegeboard has granted official approval. Please note that these agencies do not always allow the same accommodations that your child uses in the school setting; the testing agency allows or denies accommodations at their discretion. If your child would like to apply for the allowance of testing accommodations, they must sign the permission form (attached here) and return it to Mr. Leo (angelo.leo@valleycentralschools.org) or your child's guidance counselor no later than **February 1, 2019**.

- 4) At this point, students should be well into their AP course, working hard, and preparing for their exams. AP teachers are always available for additional help, and www.collegeboard.org has a wealth of test prep information that your child may find useful.
