SPECIFIC RULES FOR DRIVERS:

- A. Students who have been granted permission to drive may drive other students to school with written permission from the parents/guardians of both students (drivers and passengers)
- B. Students may not go to their cars during the school day without specific permission from Administration and an escort. Leaving school without permission may result in the immediate suspension of your parking/driving privileges.
- C. Any reckless driving, such as speeding, squealing tires, or careless driving may result in the immediate suspension of your on-campus parking/driving privileges. Driving which endangers the safety of others may result in other disciplinary consequences in addition to the loss of parking/driving privileges in accordance with NYS Penal Law Section 145.25 and MYS Vehicle and Traffic Law Section 155.
- D. Vehicular crashes on school grounds MUST be reported to the main office immediately. Failure to report vehicular crashes may result in revocation of permit and criminal charges.
- E. Once the school buses have been given the signal to leave the school grounds, no other vehicles are to leave the parking lot. Movement from the parking lot may begin again once all the buses have left the school grounds.
- F. Student found parking in designated faculty/staff parking areas and any other non-student areas may forfeit their permit and may be subject to tow.
- G. Illegal absences from class and/or repeated level 2 disciplinary infractions may result in the suspension or permanent revoking of parking privileges.
- H. Academic Ineligibility may result in a suspension or permanent revoking of parking privileges.
- I. Students may not share parking passes without the permission of administration.
- J. Excessive unexcused LATES may result in the suspension or permanent revoking of parking privileges.
- K. Student must take the one hour Driver Safety Awareness Class offered for free.
- H. The aforementioned regulations became effective August 1, 2004, revised June 2018

***Please note on Thursday, November 1, 2018 and Tuesday, May 21, 2019 students will not be allowed to park on campus due to the College Fair and District Budget Vote.** The parking lot will be used to house all the college representatives that will be in attendance those days. Although this may cause an inconvenience to many, we feel as though it is a small price to pay for an opportunity for our students to obtain vital information and to best service our community.

"I understand that permission to drive and park a vehicle on the Valley Central High School campus is a privilege which is subjected to specific regulations and procedures outlined in the Traffic and Parking Regulations booklet and the Valley Central handbook.

I further understand that failure to obey these regulations can be punishable by tickets, revocation of driving/parking privileges, a referral to police authorities, or having my car immobilized or towed at my expense."
