Expectation Contract for Advanced/Regents Classes

Advanced Level Class Expectations

VCMS supports any student who wants to accept the challenges of an advanced class. However, the opportunity to be in advanced classes carries with it certain assumptions about the capabilities and maturity of students who will be doing advanced level work.

Student is enrolled in the following regents' classes:

Students are expected:

1. To maintain an 88 overall average (**before** the 5% grade bump). The **minimum** grades for each category are:
 - a. 85 homework average
 - b. 80 test average
 - c. 80 quiz average
2. To complete **ALL** labs and weekly reviews on time.

If the above requirements are not met, an individual contract will be signed at the 5 week period. If they are still not met at the 10 week marking period the student will be transferred to a regular 8th grade course.

For students to be placed in advanced level courses in the High School, a year end average of at least an 88 in the course and an 80 on the New York State Regents must be achieved.

Students who enroll in advanced level courses and their parent/guardian must sign the contract to remain enrolled in those courses.
