# Marcia McDermott

## Camp Director

Marcia McDermott was named the head coach of the Army Black Knights in January 2013. Her most recent coaching assignment was as an assistant coach for the U.S. Women's National Team in 2011. With over 20 years of coaching experience under her belt, Coach McDermott will lead the Army program which has earned two NCAA Championship berths in the past five seasons.



Coach McDermott has extensive experience at the college level. She was Northwestern University's first head coach, starting the program in 1994 and leading them to the NCAA tournament in 1996 and the third-round in 1998. She later coached as an assistant at Illinois in 2006 and 2007, where the team earned NCAA Tournament berths both years.

As a student-athlete, she played at the University of North Carolina winning three national titles (1983, '84 and '86) during her tenure. She was an All-American in 1986 and went on to play for the U.S. WNT in 1986 and 1988.

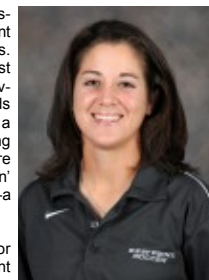
Coach McDermott also coached in the professional ranks in 2001 as the head coach of the Carolina Courage during its premier season in the Women's United Soccer Association. The Courage won the 2002 regular season and the post-season Founder's Cup following a 12-4-5 campaign. She returned to the professional game in 2008, serving as the General Manager of the Chicago Red Stars of Women's Professional Soccer through 2010. She maintained her duties as a scout for the U.S. National Team, including terms during the 2008 Beijing Olympics and 2012 London Olympics, where U.S.A. captured Gold Medals each year, respectively.

She looks to build on her experiences as she guides a passionate and dedicated Army Women's Soccer Team in 2013!

# Renée Pilch

## Assistant Camp Director

Army Assistant Coach Renée Pilch will serve as the Assistant Camp Director. She worked camp at West Point for many summers and is eager to extend her experiences. She will serve as Camp Director for the Day Camp and assist with residential camp direction/coordination. Currently serving as an assistant for the Black Knights, Renée holds licenses from NSCAA and USSF, and has spent time as a youth coach, in ODP and club soccer scenes. Before coming to West Point, she was at Gardner-Webb University, where she served as a goalkeeper coach. She helped the Runnin' Bulldogs become Big South Tournament Runners-Up—a first for the program.



As a player, Renée gained Division I experience at two major universities—University of Pittsburgh (Big East) and Belmont University (Atlantic Sun)—as a goalkeeper. At Belmont, she helped the Bruins to the 2008 Atlantic Sun Tournament title and NCAA bid as a junior. Her senior year, her goalkeeper unit ranked 35th nationally in save percentage, when the Bruins captured the 2009 Regular Season Conference title. A northeast PA native, Renée played for Valley View, where the two-time all-region selection set a school mark for scoreless minutes (723).

Renée has a deep passion and enthusiasm for coaching. There is nothing she enjoys more than working to inspire young players through the game of soccer, hoping to build foundations and to instill values for years to come.

The Camp Staff has a unique mix of energetic coaches and college players, from all levels of experience, committed to player development. Your daughter will receive training in individual fundamentals and team concepts, a t-shirt and a soccer ball. There will be daily competitions, player evaluations and an awards ceremony. A full-time Athletic Trainer is on staff and there is always adult supervision.

## Camp Highlights

### Develop Soccer Interest

Individual instruction will be emphasized by all the camp coaches. The camp will be staffed at a ratio of 1:8.

### Individual Instruction

Our goal is to build a strong desire within each camper to continue to develop after camp ends. This will be obtained through daily lectures, demonstrations, drills and competition.

### Functional Training

Coaches will focus on the individual offensive/defensive skills to developing competitive players. Fast footwork, dribbling, passing, receiving, heading, shooting and finishing will be emphasized

### Goalkeeper Training

All Goalkeepers will be involved in small group instruction with goalkeeping coaches. An emphasis will be placed on technique, tactics, and positioning.

### Game Competition

Games will be played in the evenings, starting on the first night of camp. Please indicate position on the application. The position and age will be used to establish the initial teams. Adjustments may be made after the first night.

### Soccer Films/Lectures
