

Due to the health hazards associated with smoking, and in accordance with Federal and State law, the Board of Education prohibits smoking, the use of e-cigarettes or any other device used to inhale any non-prescribed substance, or other tobacco use in all school buildings, on school property, or at school-sponsored activities. Smoking or tobacco use is also prohibited within 100 feet of all school entrances, exits and outdoor areas, except when in a residence or on a residential property.

The District's smoking policy shall be prominently posted in each building. The Board designates the Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee as agent responsible for informing individuals smoking in a non-smoking area that they are in violation of Article 13 of the Public Health Law and/or Federal Pro-Children Act of 1994.
