

Students instructed at home by their parents are not entitled to participate in interscholastic or intramural sports. However, the Superintendent or designee may permit such students to participate in non-credit-bearing organized school activities such as clubs (other than interscholastic or intramural sports), as long as they can provide either documentation of immunization to, or a medical exemption for immunization from, the same communicable diseases required for entry into the public schools.
