***Terminology Clarification:** For purposes of this solicitation, the terms “bid” and “proposal” may be used interchangeably within required certification language mandated by statute. Notwithstanding such usage, this solicitation constitutes a competitive Request for Bid, and all submissions shall be treated as bids, with all respondents considered bidders, in accordance with New York State General Municipal Law §103.*

## **SECTION I – BID SUBMITTAL**

### **BID REQUIREMENTS**

To ensure a uniform and equitable evaluation process, each bid submission must include the following items:

#### **1. Bid Cover Sheet**

Include the Request for Bid title and number, company name, address, telephone number, name and title of the primary contact person, and submission date. (Use Attachment A: Bid Cover Sheet.)

#### **2. Company Qualifications Summary**

Provide an overview of the company, including prior or current projects that demonstrate the bidder’s qualifications to perform the required work.

#### **3. Bid Pricing Sheet**

Provide a unit cost for each item specified in this RFB, in accordance with the requirements outlined in Section VII – Specifications. (Use Attachment B: Bid Pricing Sheet.)

#### **4. Gym Wall Padding Mockups**

Submit a full-color mockup of the proposed gym wall padding for each building and gym. Wall padding shall be Royal Blue, and all logos or lettering must use the District-approved colors identified in Section VII. Award of work under this RFB is contingent upon the District’s written approval of the submitted mockups.

#### **5. Certificate of Insurance**

Provide a certificate of insurance that meets the requirements outlined in (Attachment C.)

**6. Required Certifications**

Submit a completed Non-Collusion Certification and Iran Divestment Act Certification. (Attachments D and E.)

**7. References**

Provide a minimum of three (3) references from clients with whom the bidder has worked within the past five (5) years. (Use Attachment F.)

**8. New York State Department of Labor Registration Certificate**

Submit a copy of the bidder's current and valid New York State Department of Labor registration certificate, as required for public works contracts. Failure to submit this documentation may result in disqualification.

**FORM OF SUBMITTAL**

Bidders shall submit one (1) clearly labeled original and one (1) copy of the bid submission and all required attachments. Submissions must be enclosed in a sealed package clearly identifying the submitting firm and addressed as follows:

Bidders submitting a bid by mail are responsible for allowing sufficient delivery time. Please note that daily U.S. Postal Service mail frequently arrives at the District after 3:00 p.m. Bids received after the deadline will not be considered, regardless of the method of delivery. Submissions transmitted by email or facsimile will not be accepted. The District assumes no responsibility for bids that are late, lost, or misdirected.

## **SECTION II – GENERAL INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS**

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

The Valley Central School District is located in Orange County, New York, and operates one (1) high school, one (1) middle school, four (4) elementary schools, and the Alternative Learning Center at Maybrook.

### **SUMMARY STATEMENT**

The purpose of this Request for Bid (RFB) is to secure a qualified vendor to manufacture, deliver, and install gym wall padding for the Valley Central School District at the following locations:

1. Valley Central High School
2. Valley Central Middle School
3. Berea Elementary School
4. East Coldenham Elementary School
5. Montgomery Elementary School
6. Walden Elementary School
7. Alternative Learning Center at Maybrook

## **SECTION III – GENERAL REQUIREMENTS**

### **INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS**

The submission of a Bid shall constitute conclusive evidence that the Bidder:

1. Has read and understands all instructions, specifications, and conditions contained in this Request for Bid;
2. Agrees to be bound by all terms and conditions governing this RFB; and
3. Understands and agrees to comply with the requirements for delivery, manufacture, and installation of the services specified herein.

### **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

All required forms and attachments must be completed and submitted with the Bid. A complete Bid submission is required for consideration.

Each Bid submitted shall be considered a binding offer. Prices submitted may not be changed after award. Upon award, the successful Bidder shall be required to provide all goods and services specified in this RFB in accordance with the submitted Bid and contract terms.

Questions must be received no later than 3:00 p.m. on Wednesday, April 15, 2026.

Responses to questions will be prepared in writing and distributed to all vendors of record, when applicable, in the form of an addendum. Such written responses shall be binding on all bidders.

No oral explanations or interpretations by any District employee or representative shall be binding on the District.

Under no circumstances may any firm or its representatives contact any employee, officer, or Board member of the District regarding this RFB, except as expressly permitted in this section. Strict adherence to this requirement is mandatory.

## **SECTION IV – INFORMATION TO BIDDERS**

### **GENERAL SCOPE**

The District intends to select a single vendor to manufacture, deliver, and install gym wall padding at all locations identified in this RFB. The selected vendor must demonstrate the ability to meet the District's standards for quality, performance, and value.

It is anticipated that the Board of Education will consider appointment of the successful Bidder at its May 11, 2026 Board of Education meeting.

### **AWARD OF CONTRACT**

The District will award a contract to the Bidder whose submission is determined to be the most advantageous to the District. Evaluation criteria may include, but shall not be limited to, price, qualifications, and the Bidder's prior performance with the District.

The bid documents and the successful Bidder's submission shall collectively constitute a binding contract, obligating the successful Bidder to furnish and perform all work in accordance with the terms and conditions of this RFB.

### **BIDDER NOTIFICATION**

The successful Bidder shall be notified via email and/or purchase order following approval by the Board of Education.

### **RIGHT TO AWARD, SCOPE OF WORK**

The District reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to award the contract for all, some, or none of the gymnasium locations identified in this Request for Bid. The District may determine the final scope of work based upon bid pricing, budgetary constraints, availability of funds, or any other factors deemed relevant by the District.

Submission of a bid shall constitute acknowledgment and acceptance by the bidder that the District is not obligated to award work for all listed locations, and that quantities and locations identified in this bid are estimates only and may be adjusted prior to award.

### **PRICING**

Prices submitted shall be firm for the duration of the contract. Any changes or increases in pricing must be mutually agreed upon in writing by the District.

### **PREVAILING WAGE RATES**

All work performed under this contract that constitutes public works shall be subject to the prevailing wage provisions of New York State Labor Law. Any violation of public works laws, labor laws, or OSHA regulations deemed serious or willful may result in a determination of non-responsibility, rejection of a Bid, or termination of contract.

## **INVOICING**

Itemized invoices shall be prepared for each service performed and submitted to:

Invoices shall clearly reference the applicable purchase order number and shall itemize labor, materials, and services provided.

For any work subject to the prevailing wage provisions of New York State Labor Law, each invoice must be accompanied by certified payroll records for the corresponding billing period.

Certified payroll submissions shall:

1. Be prepared in accordance with New York State Labor Law requirements;
2. Include the names of workers, job classifications, hours worked, wage rates, deductions, and net pay; and
3. Be signed and certified by the Contractor as true, accurate, and complete.

Failure to submit required certified payroll documentation may result in the withholding of payment until such documentation is received and verified by the District. Payment will not be approved for any labor performed without compliant certified payroll records.

## **PAYMENT TERMS**

Payment shall be made following delivery and installation of the gym wall padding, net thirty (30) days from receipt of a valid invoice.

## **SECTION V – GENERAL CONDITIONS**

Bids received after the time stated in the Notice to Bidders may not be considered and may be returned unopened. The Bidder assumes full responsibility for timely delivery.

Sales to school districts are not subject to fair-trade agreements pursuant to New York State General Business Law.

The District is exempt from federal, state, and municipal sales and excise taxes. Bid prices shall be net of such taxes.

Under penalty of perjury, the Bidder certifies that:

1. The Bid was independently arrived at without collusion; and
2. The contents of the Bid have not been disclosed prior to opening.

No oral interpretation of the specifications or contract documents shall be binding upon the District.

## SECTION VI – TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The issuance of this RFB request constitutes only an invitation to submit a response to the District.

1. This RFB request does not commit the District either to award a contract or to pay any costs incurred in the preparation of a submission. Bidders shall bear all costs associated with submission preparation, submission and attendance at presentation interviews, or any other activity associated with this bid request or otherwise.
2. All bids and accompanying documentation become the property of the Valley Central School District. The District shall not divulge any information presented to anyone outside the District, unless required by law, without the written approval of the individual or firm. The District reserves the right to use the information and any ideas presented in any submission in response to this RFB, whether or not the submission is accepted. Submitted bids may be reviewed and evaluated by any person or outside consultant retained by the District, other than one associated with a competing applicant, as designated by the District. If a bidder believes that any information in its bid constitutes a trade secret and wishes such information not be disclosed if requested by a member of the public pursuant to the State Freedom of Information Law, Article 6 of the Public Officers Law, the bidder shall submit with its bid a letter specifically identifying the page number, line or other appropriate designation, that information which it deems to constitute a trade secret and explain in detail why such information is a trade secret. Failure by a bidder to submit such a letter with its bid identifying trade secrets shall constitute a waiver by the applicant of any rights it may have under Section 89 (Subdivision 5) of the Public Officers Law relating to protection of trade secrets.
3. The District neither makes nor assumes any contractual obligation by issuing this RFB receiving and evaluating responses, or making preliminary bidder selections. Providing a response as provided herein shall neither obligate nor entitle a bidder to enter into a contract with the District.
4. The District reserves the right to determine in its sole and absolute discretion whether any aspect of the bidder's submission satisfactorily meets the criteria established in this RFB, the right to seek clarification from any bidder(s), and the right to cancel and/or amend, in part or entirely, the RFB at any time prior to a written contract.
5. It is understood that any submission received and evaluated by the Valley Central School District will be used as the basis for the cost and terms of an agreement between the District and the particular bidder. In submitting a response, it is understood by the bidder that the District reserves the right to accept any submission, to reject any and/or all submissions and to waive any irregularities or informalities that the District deems is in its best interest.
6. The District is not obligated to respond to any submission nor is it legally bound in any manner whatsoever by the submission of a response.
7. Each response shall be reviewed for completeness and for the technical and administrative requirements of the RFB. The District has the option of requesting the bidder to submit missing information or provide clarification of those issues deemed

incomplete, or disqualifying the bid. A bidder may be disqualified for lack of response to such a request.

8. RFB responses submitted to the District must be valid for a period of at least 120 days from the deadline for receipt of bid responses as defined in the time frame section of this document.
9. The selected bid will become part of any resulting legal contract, should contracts be awarded. The term of the resultant contract shall commence upon award and shall remain in effect until completion, inspection, and final acceptance of specified project(s) unless terminated, canceled, or extended as otherwise provided herein.
10. When specifications are revised, the Valley Central School District will issue an addendum addressing the nature of the change. Bidders must sign and include it in the returned bid package.
11. It is a requirement that bidders indicate specifically in the response any sub-contract, alliance, partner, franchise, or other “non-employee” relationship with any resource(s) they will utilize if they are chosen as the selected bidder. Note: The District reserves the right to approve and designate sub-contractors to be used in any of the services being proposed.
12. Valley Central School District reserves the right to introduce additional factors not contained in this RFB in order to obtain the most suitable solution. After submitting a bid, each respondent must be prepared to have the operational aspects of their bid reviewed in detail by District representatives.
13. At any time prior to the specified bid due time and date, a vendor (or designated representative) may withdraw their submission.
14. The District Board of Education reserves the right to award a contract or contracts based on the best interests of the District. The Board of Education’s decision will be final.
15. Bidders Default – Failure of the Bidder to comply with any of these provisions may be considered a reason for rejection of the Bid.

## SECTION VII - SPECIFICATIONS

### SCOPE

The Valley Central School District requires a vendor to manufacture, deliver and install gym wall padding at Valley Central High School, Valley Central Middle School, Berea Elementary School, East Coldenham Elementary School, Montgomery Elementary School, Walden Elementary School and the Alternative Learning Center at Maybrook based on the approximate linear feet and current height as outlined in the chart below.

## ATTACHMENT –C-INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

1. Commercial General Liability Insurance (including contractual liability coverage) insuring against damages to persons and property (including, but not limited to, loss of life) in an amount not less than a combined single limit of at least One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) for each occurrence and Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000) for General Aggregate (on a per project basis).
2. Automobile Liability Insurance (including non-owned or hired vehicles) insuring against damages to persons and property (including, but not limited to, loss of life) in an amount not less than a combined single limit of at least One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) for each occurrence.
3. Worker's Compensation Insurance covering hazardous material abatement consultant and its agents and employees at the New York Statutory limit including Employers' Liability with statutory New York State limits (unlimited).
4. Umbrella or Excess liability Insurance with a limit of \$2,000,000.00 per occurrence and a general aggregate of \$2,000,000.00.
5. All insurance will be affected under standard form policies by insurers of recognized responsibilities which are licensed to do business in the State of New York and which are rated as A-(VIII) or better by the latest edition of AM Best's Rating Guide or other recognized replacement therefore. Except as otherwise provided to the contrary in this Section, any insurance required by this Agreement may be obtained by means of any combination of primary and umbrella coverages and by endorsement and/or rider to a separate or blanket policy and/or under a blanket policy in lieu of a separate policy or policies, provided that hazardous material abatement consultant shall deliver said separate or blanket policies and/or endorsements and/or riders evidencing to Owner that the same complies in all respects with the provisions of this Agreement and that the coverages
6. Waiver of Subrogation - Contractor waives all rights against Valley Central School District and their agents, officers, directors and employees for recovery of damages to the extent these damages are covered by commercial general liability, commercial umbrella liability, business auto liability, garage keepers liability, or workers compensation and employers liability insurance maintained per requirements above.
7. Certificate of Insurance - Prior to commencing "the Work" described in this Agreement, Contractor shall provide Valley Central School district a Certificate of Insurance evidencing compliance with the insurance procurement requirements herein, in standard ACORD form. Notice of Change or Cancellation - No policy will permit cancellation, non-renewal, material change or modification without thirty (30) days prior written notice to the Valley Central School District.

8. If Contractor fails to procure insurance for Valley Central School District as required, recoverable damages shall not be limited to the cost of premiums for such additional insurance, but shall include all sums expended, and damages incurred by Valley Central School District, and their respective insurers, which would have otherwise been paid by the Contractor's required insurance.

All policies for each insurance shall include Valley Central School District as additional insured on a primary and noncontributory basis (this requirement shall not apply to workers' compensation insurance, employers' liability insurance or professional liability insurance).

Insurance certificate must be provided prior to the commencement of any work.

1. Independent Pricing  
The prices in this bid have been arrived at independently without collusion, consultation, communication, or agreement for the purpose of restricting competition as to any matter relating to such prices, with any other bidder or competitor.
2. No Prior Disclosure  
Unless otherwise required by law, the prices quoted in this bid have not been knowingly disclosed by the bidder, and will not knowingly be disclosed prior to bid opening, directly or indirectly, to any other bidder or competitor.
3. No Bid Suppression  
No attempt has been made or will be made by the bidder to induce any other person, partnership, or corporation to submit or refrain from submitting a bid for the purpose of restricting competition.

A bid shall not be considered for award, nor shall any award be made, where the foregoing certifications have not been complied with; provided, however, that if a bidder cannot make the

foregoing certification, the bidder shall submit, with the bid, a signed statement setting forth in detail the reasons therefor. Where such disclosure is required, the bid shall not be considered for award unless the head of the purchasing unit, or his/her designee, determines that the disclosure was not made for the purpose of restricting competition.

The fact that a bidder:

- (a) has published price lists, rates, or tariffs covering the items being procured;
- (b) has informed prospective customers of pending or proposed publication of new or revised price lists; or
- (c) has sold the same items to other customers at the same prices being bid

shall not, without more, constitute a disclosure within the meaning of the non-collusion provisions.

**Corporate Authorization:**

Any bid submitted by a corporate bidder shall be deemed to have been duly authorized by the bidder's Board of Directors. Such authorization shall be deemed to include the signing and submission of the bid and the inclusion therein of this non-collusion certification as the act and deed of the corporation.
